SHAUKAT KHANUM MEMORIAL CANCER HOSPITAL & RESEARCH CENTRE

Shaukat Khanum Memorial Cancer Hospital and Research Centres (SKMCH&RC) are state-of-the-art cancer centres located in Lahore, Peshawar, and Karachi Pakistan. SKMCH&RC, Lahore was the first project of the Shaukat Khanum Memorial Trust, which is a charitable organization established under the Societies Registration Act XXI of 1860 of Pakistan.

INSPIRATION FOR MAKING THE HOSPITAL

Shaukat Khanum Memorial Cancer Hospital and Research Centre is the brainchild of Pakistan's Cricket World Cup winning captain and the 22nd Prime Minister of Pakistan, Mr. Imran Khan. The inspiration to build the Hospital came after his mother, Mrs. Shaukat Khanum, succumbed to cancer in 1985. During his mother's illness, he witnessed up-close the plight of poor cancer patients in the hospitals of Pakistan and realised the need for a specialized cancer centre in his country. Being a developing country, where many do not have access to even elementary health care facilities, cancer was considered the ultimate symbol of hopelessness and almost certain death. Prior to the establishment of Shaukat Khanum Memorial Cancer Hospital and Research Centre in Lahore, no specialised institution for the comprehensive treatment of cancer existed in Pakistan. Imran Khan therefore decided to embark upon his dream of making cancer care accessible to the people of his country, regardless of their ability to pay. Hence, began the story of the enduring love of a son for his mother and of the passion of a nation.

For more than two decades, SKMCH&RC has been committed to the highest standards of patient care, education, and research. The Hospital's commitment has been recognized at both, national and international levels.

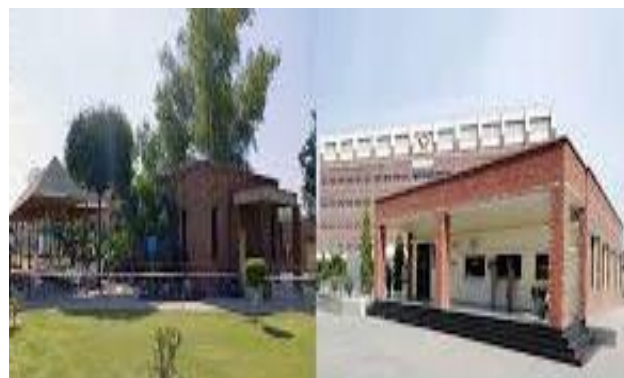

- Age Limit: 14-35 years
- Gender Ratio: Open merit

Post RN BS Nursing Program (2 Years):

- Matric with Science (Marks as per PNC Criteria)
- Diploma in Nursing
- Diploma in Midwifery (any Post Basic Specialty for male)
- 2 Year Experience as RN

Post Basic Diploma Programs (DCCN/DIPON/DION):

- Matric with Science (Marks as per PNC Criteria)
- Diploma in General Nursing
- 2 Year Experience as RN

Admission Test:

In addition to the stated admission requirements, candidates must pass the admission test at SKIHS.

Interview:

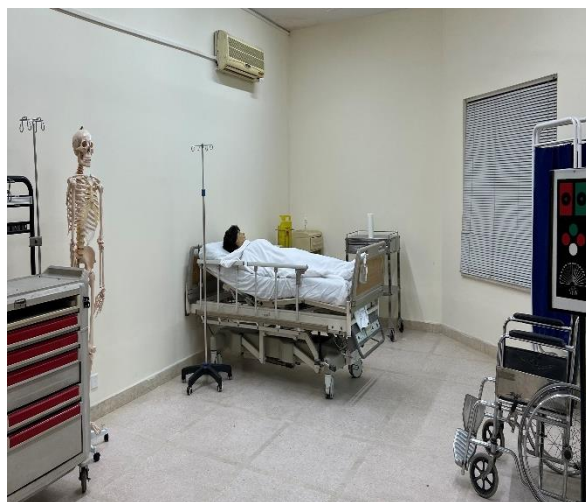
Candidates who pass the admission test and meet the above requirements will be shortlisted for the interview by a panel.

Medical Fitness:

The external candidates will be required to undergo Physical Examination conducted by the Employee Health Department of Shaukat Khanum Memorial Cancer Hospital and Research Centre and receive the medical fitness certificate to be admitted to the program.

SKILLS LAB



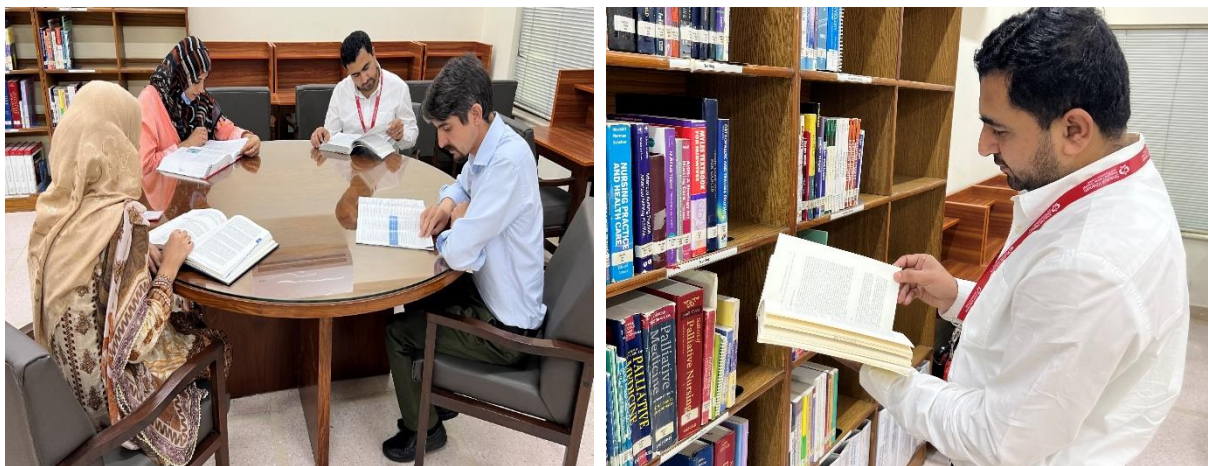
The Skills Lab at SKIHS offers the students to develop and master clinical skills to be able to correctly examine, diagnose, and provide care for future patients. The skills lab is equipped with mannequins, dummy arms, legs, and backs. Student through these resources are able to learn skills such as phlebotomy, administration of Intravenous, Intramuscular, Subcutaneous, Intradermal injections, and dressing etc.

SCIENCE LAB



The Science Lab at SKIHS are equipped with the latest apparatus and chemicals required for each specific subject such as Microbiology, Biochemistry, and Pharmacology, etc.

LIBRARY



There is an extensive collection of original textbooks, reference books, illustrated collections, and up-to-date journals which serves as a guide to students, staff, and faculty. The library is regularly updated to meet the requirements set by Pakistan Nursing Council & University of Health Sciences Lahore.

LECTURE HALLS



There are 5 lecture halls and two tutorials rooms which can house 35-50 students. The lecture halls are fully air-conditioned and equipped with multimedia, online video conferencing facilities, high speed internet, and latest computers. The design of the lecture halls ensure a environment favorable for both learning and teaching.

LEARNING RESOURCE CENTRE



The Learning Resource Centre currently has 25 computers catering the needs of students. Students at SKIHS have been provided with the opportunity to experience community health services at UC-256 Ali-Razaabad. In this community, students learn about the primary and secondary health care services provision and organize different activities for community and school health. The common activities performed by students are: Windshield survey (physical visit of the community and facilities mentioned above), identifying needs of the community. Visiting schools in order to identify the health needs of children, and conduct formal and informal teaching sessions to the members of the community and school students. Furthermore, students also organize health projects in community and school separately.
